

FULL-TIME, TENURE-TRACK, ASSISTANT PROFESSOR IN ART HISTORY

The University of South Alabama Visual Arts Department invites applications for a tenure-track Assistant Professor position in Art History beginning August 15, 2012.

Responsibilities: Teach undergraduate Art History survey courses, Art Appreciation, and upper division courses in European Medieval, Renaissance, and Baroque/Rococo art. The successful candidate will be encouraged to develop new courses in her/his area of specialization. Other duties include active scholarly research, academic advising, participation in departmental and university governance, professional development, and public service.

Required Credentials: Earned Ph.D. in art history at the time of appointment and fluency in written and spoken English.
