Preference will be given to candidates for the position whose doctoral degree is from an APA accredited program and internship. Candidates should be licensed or eligible for licensure in the State of Alabama. Area of specialization is open. Candidates will be expected to maintain an active research program and be able to mentor students in our graduate and undergraduate programs.
