7.	Perform endotracheal suctioning followed by thorough oropharyngeal and/or nasopharyngeal suctioning (according to suctioning protocol)	_____
8.	Allow patient a period of rest following suctioning while tape holding endotracheal tube is loosened or cut.	_____
9.	Deflate cuff and pull tube, encourage deep breath and cough with pulling of tube.	_____
10.	Place ordered oxygen delivery device on patient.	_____
11.	Encourage deep breathing and coughing.	_____
12.	Observe patient carefully for approximately 15 minutes. Monitor pulse rate and respiratory rate. Perform auscultation. Perform assessment of oxygenation status (pulse oximetry, ABGs)	_____
13.	Record data in progress notes to include breath sounds, vital signs, pulse oximetry (if done), ABGs (if done), and any other assessment information.	_____
14.	Complete any departmental paperwork.	_____
