

541/Beverly/Fall 2010 Annotated Bibliography and Summary Paper on Intervention

Getting Started: Begin by creating an account with [Turnitin.com](http://www.turnitin.com). Go to www.turnitin.com. In the top right corner under the login box, see “create a user profile.” Go to this link where you will be asked to enter the **course id number and the instructor password** (announced in class). After you enter these, you will enter your email address and a password that will enable you to login to the class account for the remainder of the semester. **You’re expected to create an account by the end of the second week of classes, 9/2/10.**

Purposes of these Assignments:

1. To *read* professional research relevant to a clinical issue in the field of articulation and phonology.
2. To summarize research of a clinical issue in the field of articulation and phonology by *writing*.

Process Steps for Your Assignment:

1. Begin researching the field of articulation and phonology. Select an intervention issue and locate 6 to 8 professional journal articles that are relevant to this topic. **Read the articles** and state the main idea for each one in a sentence or two to create an annotated bibliography (See attached description and examples).
2. Write a Statement of Purpose paragraph explaining the intervention issue you have selected.
3. Submit your annotated bibliography and statement of purpose. **DUE 10/12/10.**
4. After your annotated bibliography has been graded, you and the instructor will choose 3 to 5 articles from your bibliography related to your selected issue that will form the basis of your summary paper.
5. Write a summary paper focused on your intervention issue and based on the selected readings. You may submit a completed version of your paper to the instructor for review on or before the early review date. **Early review date is 11/16/10.** When you submit your paper, Turnitin.com will run a search of the database to determine an originality rating for your paper. The database includes other papers submitted for this project, the Internet, and the ProQuest search engine.
6. Rewrite the first version given feedback from the instructor. Submit the final product of your summary paper by the due date. **Summary paper DUE 12/07/10.**

Products:

Annotated Bibliography and Statement of Purpose – a paragraph description of an intervention issue with a relevant, current bibliography of 6 to 8 journal article references with individual notes regarding each reference, **presented in APA format.**

Summary Paper - well-written, thoughtful summary of several research articles outlining an intervention method/issue. **Paper will be 3 to 5 pages (see APA for all aspects including page set-up, headings, and citations).**

Grading:

This project is worth 75 points (Annotated Bibliography = 25 points, Summary Paper = 50 points). Grading will be based upon the following criteria:

Quality of Content -

- A = outstanding work that makes a perceptive and thoughtful response to the task
- B = goes beyond the routine response, evidence of thought and planning
- C = carries out the goal or assignment in a routine way
- D = weak content, doesn’t show commitment to the topic or task
- F = poorly constructed, unreadable

Quality of Writing -

- A = well-developed, smooth, shows fresh perspective, with very few, minor mechanical errors, no significant problems with organization
- B = clear, jargon-free, with good transitions, and no distracting mechanical errors
- C = can be followed, but ideas/style lack vigor, organization or some mechanical errors may exist
- D = may be vague or ambiguous, errors in syntax and mechanics distract the reader
- F = unreadable due to serious mechanical errors
