LTC W. Don Brunson is currently a Medical Service Officer assigned as the Chief of Resource Management, Brooke Army Medical Center (BAMC), Fort Sam Houston, San Antonio, Texas. BAMC is the second largest Medical Center in the Army with over 4500 employees including about 1400 Military. The operating budget for BAMC is \$380 million dollars plus another \$64 million in GWOT funding. He has been in the job now for about 10 months after returning from Iraq while serving as the ACofS, G-8 for TF3 MEDCOM at Camp Victory for a year. TF3 MEDCOM was the C2 for all Level 2 plus and Level 3 Medical assets in the theater. He is scheduled to be the BAMC Comptroller for the next two years.

Deployed Alumni


