B.E.A.C.H.E.S. - BioEngineering And Chemical Engineering Summer Program

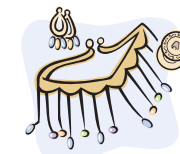


In this program, high school students will be introduced to the fundamentals of bioengineering and chemical engineering while reinforcing their biology and chemistry skills in a series of hands-on design projects. In the first half of the course, students will design and fabricate a bioengineering device that electronically tracks body temperature. In the second half of the course, they will develop a process of extracting oil from plant material and convert it to biodiesel. High School students who have taken at least one chemistry course and one biology course are encouraged to apply.
