**TRAINING STANDARDS:** When choosing a training provider, it is important to look at a program's overall training standards. All USA Emergency Response Training follows the suggested core criteria set forth in OSHA's 29 CFR 1910.120, Appendix E, "Training Curriculum Guidelines."

In addition, all USA Emergency Response Training complies with OSHA's permit-required confined space standard (29 CFR 1910.146) and meets the training requirements set forth in NFPA's "Standard on Operations and Training for Technical Rescue Technician Professional Qualifications" (NFPA 1006).

All USA Emergency Response Training complies with the U.S. Homeland Security Presidential Directive 5 (HSPD-5), Management of Domestic Incidents, which mandates a "single, comprehensive National Incident Management System (NIMS)."

## MEET YOUR INSTRUCTORS



**Paul Phillips** is the head instructor and program director of the University of South Alabama's Emergency Response Training department. He has been with the program since 2003 and has a wide range of emergency response experience. Paul has an associate's degree in fire science and has been a firefighter since 1998. He is currently employed with the City of Mobile's Fire Department, and is assigned to the fire boat as a driver/boat pilot. He has also served on Mobile's Hazardous Materials Unit, where he obtained certification as a HAZMAT Technician and as a Weapons of Mass Destruction Technician. He has extensive training in confined space rescue, including high angle rescue. In addition, he spent 4 years performing search and rescue operations in the United States Coast Guard. Overall, Paul's combined education, training, and work experience enable him to instruct students to become safety and emergency response professionals.



**Bryant Johnson** has been an instructor at the University of South Alabama's Emergency Response Training Center since 2008. Johnson has also been an EMT-D/ firefighter with the Mobile Fire-Rescue Department since 2001. He is currently assigned as a driver to the Melton Fire Station, which houses the Urban Search and Rescue Team (USAR) of Alabama Task Force One (ALTF-1). As a member of this team, since 2003, Bryant obtained technical certifications in HAZMAT, confined space rescue, high angle rescue, structural collapse, trench rescue, wildland firefighting, swift water rescue as well as certifications in firefighter I and firefighter II. The hands-on opportunity that USA's Emergency Response Training provides, allows Johnson to instruct students using his experience as a rescue technician.

## HAZWOPER TRAINING

### Hazardous Waste Operations and Emergency Response 29 CFR 1910.120

---

#### **HAZARDOUS MATERIALS TECHNICIAN** - 40 hours, \$795 per student

**2011 Course Dates:**

**Jan. 24 - 28 • Feb. 14 - 18 • Mar 28 - Apr 1  
Apr 18 - 22 • May 3 - 7 • June 14 - 18**

Designed for individuals who respond to the release of hazardous substances in order to aggressively stop the release. Required for any one who must enter a “hot zone.”

---

#### **WASTE SITE WORKER TECHNICIAN** - 40 hours, \$795 per student

**2011 Course Dates: Call for availability**

Ideal training for workers who regularly participate in activities conducted on hazardous waste sites and may be required to wear personal protective equipment.

---

#### **HAZWOPER ANNUAL REFRESHER** - 8 hours, \$175 per student

**2011 Course Dates:**

**Jan. 13 • Feb. 9 • March 17 • April 28 • May 19 • June 24**

Serves as an annual refresher for those who have completed Hazardous Materials Technician training. Refreshers are available with either a classroom or a drill option.

---

#### **INCIDENT COMMAND** - 8 hours, \$175 per student

**2011 Course Dates: Call for availability**

Prepares those who are responsible for implementing an employer’s incident command system and emergency response plan. Course also covers working with chemical protective clothing and the importance of decontamination procedures.

## TECHNICAL RESCUE TRAINING

### **TECHNICAL RESCUE: LEVEL I** - 24 hours, \$525 per student Course Dates: By Request

For industrial, public safety and military emergency responders. Course topics will include Site Operations, Victim Management, Maintenance and Ropes/Rigging, among others. The student will demonstrate competency in all job performance requirements in NFPA's "Standard for Rescue Technician Professional Qualifications" (NFPA 1006), to include the job performance requirements for at least one specialty area, such as confined space rescue.

---

### **TECHNICAL RESCUE: LEVEL II** - 24 hours, \$525 per student Course Dates: By Request

Designed to provide additional rescue skills for students who have completed Technical Rescue- Level I, with an emphasis in confined space or high angle rescue.

---

### **CONFINED SPACE ENTRY** - 8 hours, \$175 per student Course Dates: By Request

Designed to provide employees who must enter into, work in or exit from confined spaces with the awareness of the increased risks of exposure to physical injury from hazards such as entrapment, engulfment and hazardous atmospheric conditions. Students will master the skills necessary to minimize these risks.

---

**NOTE: All rescue training requires students to participate in rigorous physical activities requiring respiratory and cardiac fitness. All students are required to complete a medical evaluation form and appropriate medical release forms.**

### FIRST RESPONDER AWARENESS COURSE - 8 hours

For individuals who are likely to witness or discover a hazardous substance release and who will initiate an emergency response sequence by notifying the proper authorities.

---

### FIRST RESPONDER OPERATIONS COURSE - 16 hours

For those who respond to releases or potential releases of hazardous substances as part of the initial response to the site for the purposes of protecting nearby persons, property or the environment from the effects of the release.

---

### HAZARDOUS MATERIALS SPECIALIST - 16 hours

For individuals who respond with and provide support to hazardous materials technicians and who require a more directed or specific knowledge of the various substances they may be called upon to contain.

---

### TREATMENT, STORAGE AND DISPOSAL - 24 hours initial and 8 hour refreshers
