### **PROGRAM SCHEDULE**

Most University of South Alabama programs begin on Sunday afternoon and end with lunch on Friday. Please review the dates carefully. Please plan to stay for your entire program. Sometimes field trips must be scheduled on the final day of the program and we wouldn't want you to miss anything.

### Accommodations

The Ashbury Suites hotel has a large atrium to greet the guest. Hotel sleeping rooms are located just off of the lobby and the conference center (where our meetings and meals will be held) are located off of the lobby as well. ### Check-in and Registration

### Early Arrival/Stayover Accommodations

### Directions to Ashbury Hotel & Suites

#### From Interstate 10: East Bound

Traveling east on I-10 (coming from New Orleans/Biloxi) merge left to get on I-65 North. Travel 3.5 miles to Exit 3 Airport Blvd. Take a left onto Airport Blvd., get in the right hand lane, go over the overpass, and take a right on the I-65 West Service Road to get to Ashbury Hotel and Suites, which is on your left.

#### From Interstate 10: East Bound

Traveling west on I-10 (coming from Pensacola, Fla) Take exit 20 on the right to get on I-65 North. Travel 3.5 miles to Exit 3 Airport Blvd. Take a left onto Airport Blvd., get in the right hand lane, go over the overpass, and take a right on the I-65 West Service Road to get to Ashbury Hotel and Suites, which is on your left.

#### From Interstate 65 South Bound

Travelling South on I-65 (from Montgomery) take Exit 3/Airport Blvd. Keep right at the fork taking a right at the traffic light. After the traffic light immediately take a right onto the I-65 West Service Road proceed to Ashbury Hotel and Suites, which is on your left.

#### From Mobile Regional Airport

Exit out of the airport taking a left at the light onto Airport Blvd. Travel approximately 7 miles. Just before reaching I-65, Turn Left on the West Service Road (There will be a Shell Station and Babies R Us on the left). Proceed to Ashbury Hotel and Suites, which is on your left.

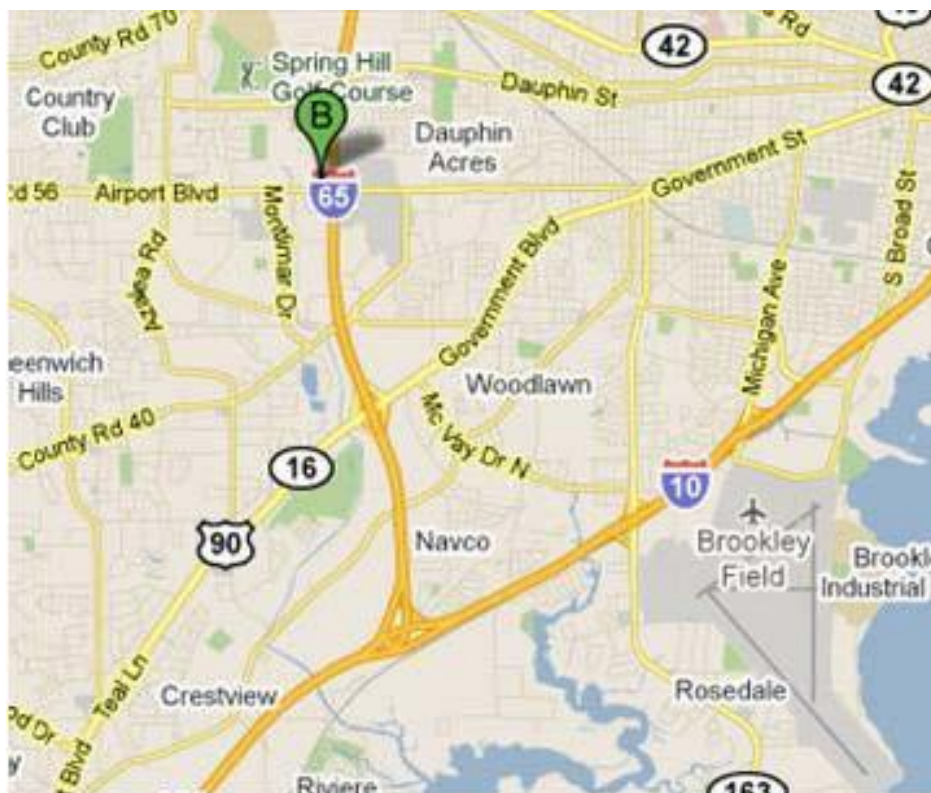

### Accommodations

On the shores of picturesque Weeks Bay and set on 54 acres of tall pines and landscaped grounds, Beckwith offers comfortable rooms with private baths and inviting Southern porches for socializing. Great birding, walking trails, and sunrises on the pier await you. One lodge is ground-level, the other is up half-a-flight. There is a ramp, but no elevator. Parking is adjacent to the buildings.

Fresh towels are provided at your request with full maid service on Wednesday. There are no phones or televisions in the sleeping rooms. Community room does provide a T.V. for local channels only. Dining room and classroom are located in separate buildings about 30 yards away. Don't forget your flashlight. There is a piano, so please bring your music. Refrigeration will be provided for medications, as needed.

### Check-In/Registration

Registration is from 4:00-5:30 p.m. at the Alves Conference Center. You will check in with a Road Scholar staff and receive your Road Scholar packet at this time. Rooms are available after 4:00 p.m. Orientation begins at 5:30 p.m. and is followed by dinner and introductions.

### Directions to Beckwith Episcopal Camp & Conference Center

**Traveling from east or west on I-10**, take exit 35 onto Hwy. 98 South to Daphne & Fairhope. Stay on four lane highway (do not exit onto Scenic Hwy. 98). Four lane highway will narrow to two lanes approximately 3 miles Hwy. 98 will intersect with Scenic Hwy 98. Turn left onto Scenic Hwy 98. Approximately 2 miles you will see a Camp Beckwith sign. Turn right onto CR 27 South (Mary Ann Beach Rd.) Continue on for Approx. 2 miles you will see a sign marking the entrance to Beckwith Camp and Conference Center on your left.

**From I-65**, Traveling south on I-65, take exit 31 for Al- 225 toward Stockton/Spanish Fort. Take a left on 225 South. Travel about 20 miles and then take a slight right at Spanish Fort Blvd. Traveling 0.2 miles take a left on Old Spanish Trail/US 98. Travel about 17 miles on Hwy 98 South to Daphne & Fairhope. Stay on four lane highway (do not exit onto Scenic Hwy. 98). The four lane highway will then narrow to two lanes. At a 4-way stop, Hwy 98 will intersect with Scenic Hwy 98. Take a left onto Scenic Hwy 98. Approximately 2 miles you will see a Camp Beckwith sign. Turn right onto Co Rd 27 South (Mary Ann Beach Rd.) Continue on for Approx 2 miles you will see a sign marking the entrance to Beckwith Camp and Conference Center on your left.

**From AL 59 North bound/US 98 East bound:** Traveling north on AL 59/ S McKenzie St., take a left on US 98/W Laurel Ave (You are in Foley AL.) Travel about 10.5 miles and you will see a Camp Beckwith and Conference Center sign. Take a left on Co Rd 27/Mary Ann Beach Rd. Continue on for approx 2 miles and you will see a sign marking the entrance to Beckwith Camp and Conference Center on your left.

**From Interstate 10, east or west**, take exit 44 to merge onto Hwy 59 at Loxley, AL. Head south on Hwy. 59, Gulf Shores Parkway, about 35 miles to Gulf Shores. Hwy. 59 ends at Hwy. 182. Turn left on Hwy. 182, East Beach Blvd, which becomes Perdido Beach Blvd. for 3.5 miles. Hilton Garden Inn is on the right side of the road.

**From Interstate 65**, Traveling south on I-65, take exit 37 south, the Bay Minette/Gulf Shores Parkway exit. Turn left on State Hwy. 287 south, then follow to State Hwy. 59 south (Gulf Shores Parkway). Travel about 60 miles to Gulf Shores. Hwy. 59 ends at Hwy. 182 (called "The T"). Turn left on Hwy. 182, East Beach Blvd, which becomes Perdido Beach Blvd. Hilton Garden Inn is 3.5 miles on the right side of the road.

### From Pensacola Airport:

Turn left on 12th Avenue entrance and go 6/10 of a mile to Bayou Blvd. Turn right on Bayou Blvd. and travel 7 miles to Blue Angel Parkway (Hwy. 173). NOTE: Bayou Blvd. changes names several times, but stay on it. Turn left on Blue Angel Parkway (Hwy. 173) 6.8 miles to Hwy. 292. Turn right on Hwy. 292, go 20 miles to Hilton Garden Inn.

**From Interstate 10**, east or west, take exit 44 to merge onto Hwy 59 at Loxley, AL. Head south on Hwy. 59, Gulf Shores Parkway, about 35 miles to Gulf Shores. Hwy. 59 ends at Hwy. 182. Turn left on Hwy. 182, East Beach Blvd, which becomes Perdido Beach Blvd. for 5.2 miles. Holiday Inn Express is on the right, next to Souvenir City.

**From Interstate 65**, Traveling south on I-65, take exit 37 south, the Bay Minette/Gulf Shores Parkway exit. Turn left on State Hwy. 287 south, then follow to State Hwy. 59 south (Gulf Shores Parkway). Travel about 60 miles to Gulf Shores. Hwy. 59 ends at Hwy. 182 (called "The T".) Turn left on Hwy. 182, East Beach Blvd, which becomes Perdido Beach Blvd. and travel 5.2 miles. The Holiday Inn Express on the right side of the road, next to Souvenir City.

### From Pensacola Airport:

Turn left on 12th Avenue entrance and go 6/10 of a mile to Bayou Blvd. Turn right on Bayou Blvd. and travel 7 miles to Blue Angel Parkway (Hwy. 173). NOTE: Bayou Blvd. changes names several times, but stay on it. Turn left on Blue Angel Parkway (Hwy. 173) 6.8 miles to Hwy. 292. Turn right on Hwy. 292, go 17 miles to Holiday Inn Express.
