

ABOUT THE CAMP...

The annual Karate Training Camp has been offered by the University of South Alabama for the past 33 years. It is designed for any style karate student. The camp focuses on basic techniques, kata and sparring utilizing Shotokan style of karate.

Mr. Mikami will serve as Lead Instructor of this year's camp. Chief Instructor of the ASKA-ISKF Southern Region, he has served as a member of the World Karate Federation Technical Committee and as an instructor at WUKO Kata Course. USA Karate Federation Man of the Year in 1989, Mr. Mikami was selected as the Instructor of the Year by Black Belt Magazine in 1990.

Our guest instructor this year, Mr. Takashina, is an Eighth Degree Black Belt and chief instructor for the South Atlantic Region of the International Shotokan Federation and ISKF Technical Director.

Both instructors have dedicated their lives and efforts to the internationalization of traditional Shotokan Karate-do. Both came from the university system of modern Japanese Karate developed by the founder of modern karate, Gichen Funakoshi. The univeristy tradition has been a dynamic base in the promotion of Shotokan Karate throughout the world. In particular, the USA Karate program originated over 41 years ago.

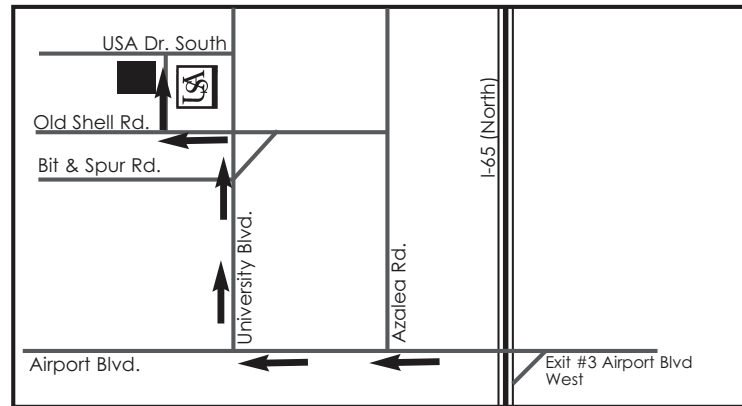
