<i>Measure</i>	<i>Description</i>
<b><i>General Achievement Tests</i></b>	
Metropolitan Achievement Tests	A group-administered test spanning the grades from kindergarten through twelfth grade and consisting of five subtests that can provide diagnostic information in the areas of reading, mathematics, and language.
Peabody Individual Achievement Test	An individually administered test spanning the grades from kindergarten through twelfth grade and consisting of six subtests.
<b><i>Achievement Tests in Specific Subareas</i></b>	
Nelson Reading Skills Test	A group administered test spanning third through ninth grades consisting of subtests measuring word meaning, and comprehension.
Cooperative Achievement Test	Used at the secondary school level, this test consists of separate achievement tests in diverse areas from literature and science to foreign language.
Basic English Skills Test	A test of basic language skills for use with any adult with limited English proficiency. Designed for use as a diagnostic and vocational counseling tool.
