The Educational Administration program is designed to enhance knowledge and skills in the area of educational administration and leadership. Educational Leadership courses empower students for advancement in educational service. Leadership programs emphasize growth from the knowledge base through practical applications and experiences. It will prepare individuals for careers in educational settings, other than P-12 public schools. This 33-hour program can be completed entirely online, however, the option to take approximately 40% of the courses in a campus-based format also exists. This program will *not* lead to certification in Instructional Leadership for P-12 school administrators.
