

William Chamberlain Technology Teaching Award

This scholarship is awarded annually to one or more full-time undergraduate students in the College of Education who have completed course EDM310 or any successor course in the College of Education that prepares students to use technology in the course of their teaching career. The recipient should be a student who demonstrates outstanding evidence of an enthusiasm for and an ability in using technology in their teaching. This scholarship will be awarded for the first time in the fall semester 2011, for the 2011-2012 academic year (50% per semester).

To be considered, your complete application must be received in the Office of Student Services by **May 13**. Recipients will be selected by a committee appointed by the Dean of the College.

Requirements for Eligibility:

- A. Must be enrolled in the USA College of Education.
- B. Must be in good standing according to University policies.
- C. Must have declared a teaching curriculum as a major to qualify.
- D. Minimum Grade Requirements:
 - University of South Alabama Cumulative GPA..... 3.00
 - Program Component Cumulative GPA..... 3.00
- E. Application must be completed fully and include all of the following to be considered:
 - 1. Personal statement and personal goals,
 - 2. Evidence of professional interest/involvement (Memberships in professional organizations, volunteer work, etc.)
 - 3. Paragraph stating why scholarship would be of help.
