

## Early Childhood Education, M.Ed.

The Master of Education (M.Ed.) program in Early Childhood Education provides advanced study for teachers working with children three through eight years of age. Successful completion of the program may qualify the candidate for the Class “A” Professional Educator certificate in Early Childhood Education provided they already hold the Class “B” Professional Educator Certificate in Early Childhood Education.

The advanced programs are extensions of basic preparation and differ from basic programs not in general purpose but in competence they seek to develop.
