

Currently the College of Education for the area of Special Education is only accepting applications for Collaborative K-6 and Collaborative 6-12.

Special Education, Early Childhood Special Education, M.Ed. or Alt. A.

This Special Education program is designed to prepare teachers in the area of Early Childhood Special Education. Successful completion of the program may qualify the candidate for the Class “A” Professional Educator Certificate.

The Alternative Master of Education, (M.Ed.) program in Early Childhood Education is designed to provide initial teacher certification at the graduate level, primarily for students interested in a career in teaching, but whose undergraduate degree did not include a teacher preparation program. Successful completion of the program may qualify the candidate for the Class “A” Professional Educator Certificate.

Advanced programs are extensions of basic preparation and differ from basic programs not in general purpose but in competence they seek to develop.
