Special Education, Early Childhood Special Education, B.S.

The Early Childhood Special Education program equips students to work with special needs students, ages birth through eight years. Training involves working with community and local education agencies. Successful completion of the program may qualify the candidate for a Class “B” Professional Educator certificate in Early Childhood Special Education (P-3).

The purpose of a teacher education program shall be to prepare prospective teachers to select, implement, and evaluate diverse strategies and resources to provide secondary students with the skills and knowledge appropriate for the individual teaching fields.
