

Elementary Education, M.Ed.

The Master of Education (M.Ed.) Program in Elementary Education provides advanced study for teachers working with children in kindergarten through grade six. Successful completion of the program may qualify the candidate for the Class “A” Professional Educator Certificate provided they already hold a Class “B” Professional Certificate in Elementary Education.

The advanced programs are extensions of basic preparation and differ from basic programs not in general purpose but in competence they seek to develop.
