

# **Elizabeth F. Martin and Wilma M. Scrivner Scholarship**

**Award Amount Varies from Year-to-Year**

This scholarship is awarded annually to a full-time **female** undergraduate student in the College of Education who plans to teach, and has been approved for financial aid by the University of South Alabama Office of Financial Aid; has attained **Junior or Senior** status in a College of Education teacher certification program); has completed 64 hours in a Teacher Education Program; has been admitted to Teacher Education Candidacy; and possesses a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.2 at the University of South Alabama, and a minimum cumulative GPA in his/her Program Component of 3.2. This scholarship will be awarded during fall semester for the academic year (50% per semester).

To be considered, completed application must be received in the Office of Student Services by **May 15<sup>th</sup>**.

## **Requirements for Eligibility:**

- A. Must have attained **Junior or Senior** Status in a College of Education undergraduate program prior to application.
- B. Must have completed 64 Program hours prior to application.
- C. Must have been admitted to Teacher Candidacy prior to application.
- D. Minimum Grade Requirements:
  - University of South Alabama Cumulative GPA..... 3.2
  - Program Component Cumulative GPA..... 3.2
- E. Application must be completed fully and include all of the following to be considered:
  - a. Personal statement and personal goals,
  - b. Evidence of Professional interest/involvement (Memberships in Professional organizations, volunteer work, etc.), and
  - c. Paragraph stating why this scholarship would be of help.
- F. Must have been approved for financial aid through the University of South Alabama Office of Financial Aid.
