GRADUATE TEACHING ASSISTANTSHIPS

GRADUATE DEGREES:

The Department of Health, Physical Education, and Leisure Studies offers Master of Education Degrees in Physical Education (P-12) and Health Education (6-12) and Master of Science Degrees in Exercise Science and Health Education.

GRADUATE ASSISTANT POSITIONS:

The University of South Alabama offers graduate teaching assistant positions through the Department of Health, Physical Education, and Leisure Studies. Appointees are assigned to teach Physical Education activity courses, assist in the Human Performance Laboratory, conduct research, and perform other duties based on Departmental needs. Twenty hours of work are required per week.

ELIGIBILITY:

Graduates of an accredited university or college with good academic standing and a minimum undergraduate grade point average minimum of 3.0 on 4.0 scale and acceptable GRE or MAT scores are eligible for consideration.

STIPENDS/TUITION WAIVERS:

Assistantships are awarded on an annual basis and are granted for the fall and spring semesters. The stipend for the two semesters is \$6,000.00 and a waiver of tuition up to 10 approved credit hours per semester. Enrollment in a minimum of 6 credit hours per semester of graduate course work is required to maintain full time status.

GENERAL INFORMATION:

The Department of Health, Physical Education, and Leisure Studies is a large department with various undergraduate and graduate program offerings in the fields of Physical and Health Education, Exercise Science, Therapeutic Recreation and Leisure Studies. The Department has state-of-the-art research and teaching equipment, multi-media classrooms, two large gymnasiums, a weight room, dance studio, martial arts studio, a human performance laboratory, and a fully equipped student computer laboratory.
