The department offers the Master of Education (M.Ed.) program in Education, and the Alternative Master’s degree in Education, both preparing candidates for an Alabama Class A Teaching Certificate. The Sixth-Year Graduate Program for Educational Specialist (Ed.S.) prepares candidates for an Alabama Class AA Professional Educator Certificate as an Instructional Specialist in selected teaching fields. The advanced programs are extensions of basic preparation and differ from basic programs not in general purpose but in competence they seek to develop.
