The Department of Leadership and Teacher Education in the College of Education at the University of South Alabama is seeking applicants for an Assistant Professor for a tenure-track position in its Special Education program, available August 15, 2007.

Applicants must have an earned doctorate in Special Education or a related field. Preference will be given to those with P-12 teaching experiences with children who have mild learning and behavior challenges. Experience in adapting instruction in curricular areas, such as reading and math, is preferred. Responsibilities include teaching undergraduate and graduate courses, supervising students in field/clinical settings, extensive advising, scholarly research and productivity, service on college and department committees, and working with local education agencies.

A complete application must include a letter of interest, a current vita, official transcripts, and three original letters of reference.
