

Special Education, Collaborative K-6, B.S.

The Collaborative K-6 program is designed to prepare teachers to function in a variety of special education settings. Training involves working with community and local education agencies. Successful completion of the program may qualify the candidate for a Class “B” Professional Educator certificate in Special Education Collaborative (K-6).

The purpose of a teacher education program shall be to prepare prospective teachers to select, implement, and evaluate diverse strategies and resources to provide secondary students with the skills and knowledge appropriate for the individual teaching fields.
