

## Secondary Education, Social Science Composite, M.Ed. or Alt. A

The Master of Education (M.Ed.) program is designed to enhance and extend the knowledge and qualifications of secondary Social Science teachers. Successful completion of the program may qualify the candidate for the Class “A” Professional Educator Certificate provided they already hold a Class “B” Professional Certificate in Secondary Education, Social Science Composite.

Advanced programs are extensions of basic preparation and differ from basic programs not in general purpose but in competence they seek to develop.
