

College of Education Graduate Transfer Credit Procedures

A maximum of nine (9) semester hours of approved transfer credit is allowed for a master's degree, when a student has at least 9 hours of USA graduate work and in regular status. Transfer credit from regionally accredited universities may be accepted by certain programs. Prior approval of the college Director of Graduate Studies is required. Only courses with "A" or "B" grades are acceptable for transfer. See specific Ph.D. program for transfer credit policy. The University of South Alabama does not award graduate credit for prior portfolio-based experiential learning. Likewise students cannot transfer in courses that they have used to meet degree requirements for previous master's degrees.
