

MASTER'S LEVEL ASSISTANTSHIPS

Graduate Assistants are appointed in the summer of each year for the following Fall and Spring semesters. The stipend is \$6,000.00 per year with course fees up to a maximum of ten hours each semester waived. All other fees must be paid by the student. Graduate Assistants are permitted to enroll for only ten hours during any one semester.

As a part of the graduate assistantship, twenty hours of inservice per week to the College of Education is required during University business hours of 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Graduate assistants who wish to be employed in addition to their graduate assistantship assignments, must receive permission from the appropriate Graduate Director. Normally, permission will be granted in there is no conflict with academic or assistantship responsibilities.

To be considered for an assistantship, a student must:

- 1. Be in "Regular Admission" status (requires minimum 3.00 gpa).**
- 2. Submit three letters of recommendation.**

Doctoral Assistants are appointed each year for the following Fall, Spring, and Summer semesters. The stipend is \$11,000.00, and course fees up to a maximum of ten hours each semester are waived. All other fees must be paid by the student. Doctoral Assistants are permitted to enroll for only ten hours during any one semester.

As a part of the doctoral assistantship, twenty hours of inservice per week to the College of Education is required during University business hours of 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Doctoral assistants who wish to be employed in addition to their graduate assistantship assignments, must receive permission from the appropriate Graduate Director. Normally, permission will be granted in there is no conflict with academic or assistantship responsibilities.

To be considered for an assistantship, a student must complete the attached form, submit three letters of recommendation (forms on the website), and be admitted to start or currently enrolled in the doctoral program.
