Dr. Anthony Gard, Ph.D. (1985, University of Iowa) is a Professor in the Department of Cell Biology and Neuroscience. He has taught developmental neuroscience and neuroanatomy since joining the faculty at South Alabama in 1990 after completing postdoctoral studies at the University of Connecticut School of Medicine. In 2006, he founded the College's integrated Medical Neuroscience course, offered to second year medical students in the spring semester. Dr. Gard has taught all components of the neuroscience course and specializes in developmental neuroscience, brainstem and long tract circuitry. He has consistently been evaluated as one of the College's best course directors and lecturers throughout his tenure at South Alabama.



Dr. Jeffrey Sosnowski, Assistant Professor in the Department of Pathology, received M.D. and Ph.D. degrees at the University of Louisville, where he completed his pathology residency. After earning a Ph.D. degree in anatomical sciences and neurobiology, Dr. Sosnowski completed training in neuropathology at the Johns Hopkins University. For the past five years, Dr. Sosnowski has taught pathology, embryology, histology, gross anatomy and neuroscience in a national STEP 1 board review course. He has received eight teaching awards during his training and as a faculty member.
