

Faculty Position
Director of Clinical Education/ Assistant Professor

University of South Alabama

The University of South Alabama (USA) is located on the beautiful Gulf Coast of Alabama just an hour's drive to Florida and Mississippi and about two hours east of New Orleans. Mobile is a large city with a small town feel and an abundance of southern hospitality. The Department of Physician Assistant (PA) Studies at USA is seeking candidates for a full-time, non-tenure track, 12 month faculty position at the Assistant Professor level. The position involves a 50/50 split in duties between teaching and clinical education administration. The USA Department of PA Studies offers a master's degree in Health Sciences. Both PA and physician candidates will be considered. PA candidates must be a certified Physician Assistant (PA-C) with current NCCPA certification and current license or eligibility as a physician assistant in the State of Alabama. A master's degree from an ARC-PA accredited program is required; a minimum of 3 years of clinical experience is preferred. Physician candidates must be state licensed (or license eligible) as an allopathic or osteopathic physician. This position is integral in the development of the Physician Assistant Program and accreditation. The successful candidate will work with another faculty member in the 50/50 role of Director of Clinical Education to coordinate the academic and professional progress of second year (clinical) PA students. They will provide oversight of the clinical curriculum, supervise adjunct faculty with regard to the clinical curriculum, direct End of Rotation Examinations, and assess and interpret data gathered during clinical rotations and end of year summative evaluations. The successful candidate will also participate in all standing departmental committees, maintain records as required by the program, conduct scholarly activities consistent with the goals of the department, college and university and other duties assigned which may include:

- Evaluate student progress and ensure adherence to the departmental academic and professional standards
- Instruct didactic courses in areas of need and in areas of clinical expertise
- Advise students in the PA curriculum

Review of applications will begin immediately and continue until the position is filled with a proposed start date of July 1, 2017.
