

## Department of Radiologic Sciences Non-Tenure Track Radiologic Sciences Faculty Position

The University of South Alabama invites applications for a non-tenure track, 12-month faculty position in the Department of Radiologic Sciences. Qualifications include a Master's degree in a related field with current ARRT certification in radiography and a minimum of 3 years of clinical experience in diagnostic radiography. Multidisciplinary ARRT certification, doctoral degree, and radiography teaching experience in a JRCERT-accredited program is preferred. Primary duties include didactic instruction, supervision of students in the clinical setting, service, and scholarly activity that advances the practice of diagnostic imaging. The department serves approximately 90 students annually and offers modern learning environments to include 4 energized labs, well-equipped classrooms, 12 diagnostic imaging clinical education settings, and access to a state-of-the-art simulation lab. The program is JRCERT accredited and is housed within the Pat Capps Covey College of Allied Health Professions, which offers a wide variety of research opportunities and teaching support. Application reviews begin October 2, 2017 and continue until the position is filled. The earliest available start date is January 1, 2018.
