

## Instructor Position of Biomedical Sciences

The University of South Alabama Department of Biomedical Sciences invites applications for a non-tenure track, 12-month appointment, full-time Instructor position.

Candidates for this position will be expected to demonstrate competency in teaching undergraduate students enrolled in a two semester 100-level human anatomy & physiology course. The successful candidate will possess experience in the areas of course development, use of different instructional approaches (e.g., problem-based learning), implement student remediation measures, and exhibit an ability to effectively interact with undergraduate students. The candidate is also expected to assist the 200-level A&P course instructors. Candidates must have a Master's Degree from an accredited institution in a field directly related to health sciences, a minimum of 2 years of relevant teaching experience, and the ability to operate within a multifaceted workplace.
