

Electrical and Computer Engineering Faculty Position (Assistant/Associate professor)

The Department of Electrical and Computer Engineering at the University of South Alabama invites applications for tenure-track faculty positions at the Assistant/Associate Professor level starting in the 2018-2019 academic year. Applicants must have a Ph.D. degree in electrical and computer engineering or closely related discipline by the time of hire. The department is looking for candidates who can strengthen the core competencies and have expertise in electrical engineering that include, but are not limited to power systems, power electronics, communication/digital systems, control/robotics, and other closely related research areas. Outstanding candidates in all areas of electrical and computer engineering are encouraged to apply. Applicants are expected to have a track record and ability to teach electrical and computer engineering core courses at the undergraduate and graduate level, communicate effectively, potential to establish and conduct sponsored research, and a strong publication record. Candidates from underrepresented groups are strongly encouraged to apply.

The University of South Alabama is a public, doctoral-level institution. The Electrical & Computer Engineering Department is housed in a 155,000 s.f. state-of-the-art building opened in 2012. The department offers BSEE and BSCpE degrees that are ABET accredited and the MSEE degree. The College of Engineering offers the Doctor of Science (D.Sc.) in Systems Engineering.

Located in the beautiful historic city of Mobile, the university is a public Doctoral Research-Intensive institution enrolling over 15,500 students in its nine colleges and schools.
