The Department of Professional Studies in the College of Education at the University of South Alabama is seeking applicants for a full-time tenure track academic appointment (9-month) in Counselor Education at the rank of Assistant, Associate or Full Professor.

THE UNIVERSITY OF SOUTH ALABAMA is a diverse and vibrant public university that is making a difference in the lives of the people of Alabama and the nation through teaching, research, service and health care. The University offers a wide range of high-quality undergraduate and graduate academic programs to over 16,600 students. Located in Mobile, Alabama, USA is the only major public institution of higher learning on the upper Gulf Coast and is the fastest growing university in the State.

THE COLLEGE OF EDUCATION is one of nine colleges and schools of the University of South Alabama. Founded on February 1, 1967, the college serves approximately 1,700 graduate and undergraduate students. With a total annual budget exceeding 14 million dollars, the College is able to support a broad array of degree programs. The College is nationally accredited by the National Council for the Accreditation of Teacher Education and our educator preparation programs are accredited by the Alabama State Department of Education. The counseling programs are accredited by the Council for Accreditation of Counseling and Related Educational Programs (CACREP).

THE DEPARTMENT OF PROFESSIONAL STUDIES currently has 11 tenure track faculty, 2 non-tenure track instructional faculty, and 2 staff members. The Department offers a bachelor's degree in instructional design and performance improvement, master's programs in library media, educational technology, school and clinical mental health counseling (accredited by CACREP), and instructional design. The Department delivers a doctoral program in instructional design and co-delivers along with the Department of Psychology, a doctoral program in clinical and counseling psychology (American Psychological Association accredited).

RESPONSIBILITIES include teaching courses in counselor education, developing a focused line of peer-reviewed research publications including submissions for external funding of research, and service consistent with the qualifications of the applicant and the needs of the department.

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS include an earned doctorate in Counselor Education (CED) from a CACREP-accredited doctoral program or a closely related field such as Counseling Psychology. Applicants with a Counseling Psychology doctorate, must have a master's degree from a CACREP-accredited program in order to be considered. Applicants are required to have a

successful record of teaching in a graduate program in counseling, and have demonstrated capacity for producing peer-reviewed scholarly works and securing external funding for their scholarship.

DESIRED QUALIFICATIONS include applicants with prior experience in coordinating counselor education programs and a willingness to serve as the coordinator for counselor education graduate programs. Preference will be given to applicants with a specialization in mental health counseling, with prior experience in multicultural counseling or integrated health care, or both.

COMPLETED APPLICATIONS must include a letter of interest, a current curriculum vitae, biographical data form, official transcripts (must be mailed from the institution directly to the CED Search Committee), and three signed original letters of reference (must be mailed from the originator to the CED Search Committee). Review of applicants' materials will begin November 15, 2016, and continue until the position is filled.
