A Tenure-Track Position in Mathematics

The Department of Mathematics and Statistics at the University of South Alabama invites applications for a full-time (9 month), tenure-track assistant professor position in mathematics, starting August 15, 2018.

Applicants must possess an earned doctoral degree in mathematics or a closely related field by the starting date of the appointment. Applicants should have a strong commitment to both research and teaching. Women, minorities, veterans and individuals with disabilities are strongly encouraged to apply.

Review of applications will begin on January 1, 2018, and will continue until the position is filled.

Applications should be submitted online at www.mathjobs.org, and should include a cover letter, vita, statements of teaching philosophy and research goals, three letters of recommendation, and copies of graduate transcripts. We cannot accept applications submitted directly to department faculty.

Applicants invited for an interview will be asked to complete their applications by arranging for three original signed letters of recommendation to be sent to the Department of Mathematics and Statistics. Applicants invited for an interview will also arrange to have official graduate and undergraduate transcripts sent directly by the Registrars of all colleges attended to the Department of Mathematics and Statistics.
