

Marine Fisheries Scientist

Assistant/Associate Professor of Marine Sciences.

The Department of Marine Sciences at the UNIVERSITY OF SOUTH ALABAMA (USA) invites applications for a tenure-track Assistant or Associate Professor (9 month) faculty position in the area of MARINE FISHERIES. Applicants must hold an earned Ph.D. in Marine Sciences or a closely related field and be fluent in written and spoken English. Applicants who utilize modeling and other quantitative methods in the study of fisheries oceanography, fish population dynamics, population connectivity, stock assessment, and ecosystem-based fisheries management are particularly encouraged to apply. The successful candidate will be expected to carry out research focused on local and regional fish populations in the northern Gulf of Mexico and its associated estuaries, and he/she should be willing to collaborate with an interdisciplinary group of existing faculty members in the Department (<http://www.southalabama.edu/marinesciences/>) and at the Dauphin Island Sea Lab (<http://www.disl.org/>). USA is a member of the Alabama Marine Environmental Sciences Consortium at the DAUPHIN ISLAND SEA LAB, site of the Shelby Center for Ecosystem Based Fisheries Management, where the new faculty member will be based.

The new faculty member will be expected to maintain an active, extramurally-funded research program, complement existing faculty expertise, advise M.S. and Ph.D. students, and teach courses of programmatic need in areas relevant to her/his expertise. Salary is competitive, and the start-up package is negotiable.
