

## **Speech Language Pathology Non-Tenure Track Instructor/Senior Instructor Faculty Position/Clinical Supervisor**

The University of South Alabama invites applications for a Non-Tenure Track Instructor/Senior Instructor position in the Department of Speech Pathology and Audiology. Position responsibilities include clinical education and evaluation of graduate students, maintenance of a clinical caseload, and limited classroom teaching.

The University of South Alabama (USA) is a doctoral/research-intensive institution and the Department of Speech Pathology and Audiology has been preparing undergraduate and graduate students in communication sciences and disorders since 1967. USA is located in the historic southern city of Mobile on beautiful Mobile Bay close to Gulf Coast beaches and a short drive to New Orleans.

**Qualifications:** Applicants must have, minimally, a Master's degree in Speech-Language Pathology, and individuals with Doctoral degrees in Speech-Language Pathology are encouraged to apply. Certification in Speech-Language Pathology (CCC-SLP) from the American Speech-Language-Hearing Association and eligibility for state licensure are also required. Although all qualified individuals are encouraged to apply, preferred candidates will have prior experience with clinical education of speech-language pathology graduate students, adult populations, and voice and swallowing disorders.
