Courses in Basic Life Support

Heartsaver

Designed for laypersons who have a need to know cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) and foreign body airway obstruction (FBAO) management techniques for adults. This course is useful for elementary through high school students, neighborhood groups with primarily adults and spouses caring for adults at high risk for heart attacks or strokes. Cost is \$20.

Sessions: Please call for availability.

Pediatric BLS

Designed for laypersons who need information about preventing injuries in infants and children and who need training in techniques of cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) and foreign body airway obstruction (FBAO) management in infants and small children (with body sizes approximately that of persons no greater than eight (8) years of age). The course requires four (4) hours. Cost is \$25.00.

Healthcare Provider (HCP)

Designed for health care professionals and laypersons who may need to provide either basic cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) or foreign body airway obstruction (FBAO) management in either children or adults, and who need the training to be able to provide two-rescuer cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR). The course requires eight (8) hours. Cost is \$40. Book \$15.

DIRECTIONS

The University of South Alabama Brookley Center is located on Mobile Bay. To reach the USA Brookley Center, take Interstate 10 (I-10) to the Michigan Avenue exit. Continue south on Michigan Avenue and take the first street to the left, which will be Broad Street. Travel along Broad Street for approximately 6/10 of a mile. At this point, Broad Street swings off the left, intersected by Old Bay Front Drive. Within 200 yards, Old Bay Front Drive is intersected by Commanders Drive.

Classes are held in Building 250 which is located on the corner of Old Bay Front Drive and Club Manor. Administrative offices are located at 2002 Old Bay Front Drive, 2nd floor, Room 36.

Courses in Advanced Life Support

ACLS Provider

Designed for health care professionals whose daily occupation demands proficiency in the knowledge and skills of adult resuscitation. A current BLS card is recommended. Course is taught in two consecutive eight (8) hour days. Cost is \$125. Book cost \$30.00.

PALS Provider

Designed for health care professionals whose daily occupation demands proficiency in the knowledge and skills of pediatric resuscitation. A current BLS card is recommended. Course is taught in two consecutive eight (8) hour days. Cost is \$125. Book cost \$35.00.
