What are MiniIDE and Wookie?

- MiniIDE
 - Edit assembly-language file
 - Assemble the file
- Wookie
 - Runs a simulated 68HC11 on your PC
 - Lets you watch your program run in detail



What is the process?

- Use MiniIDE to edit an assembly-language file
 - Creates a “.asm” file
- Use MiniIDE to assemble the file
 - Creates a “.s19” file – download to 68HC11
 - Creates a “.lst” file – shows every line of code
- Wookie uses the .s19 and .lst to run the code and show you the 68HC11 internals
