Please circle the scholarship below for which you are applying. Separate application forms must be completed and duplicate materials must be submitted for EACH scholarship or award for which you are applying.

1) Angelia and Steve Stokes Scholarship: Applicant must be full-time, have taken one poetry or fiction course prior to applying, and have 2.5 or above GPA. Applicant must submit 15 pages of prose fiction, creative non-fiction, or 10 pages of poetry. This award includes two undergraduate and two graduate categories. **\$1,000 per award.**

2) Shelley Memorial Scholarship: Applicant must be full-time, have taken one poetry course prior to applying, and have 2.5 or above GPA. This award goes to one graduate and one undergraduate student for excellence in poetry writing. Applicant must submit 10 pages of poetry. **\$400 per award.**

3) Jean McIver Scholarship: Applicant may be a rising junior or rising senior English major or African American Studies minor who demonstrates high academic achievement and has a 2.5 or above GPA. **\$500.**

4) Katherine Lawrence Richardson Memorial Scholarship: Awarded to a rising senior. Applicant must be full-time English or Secondary Ed major and have 2.5 or above GPA. This scholarship is based on academic excellence and additional consideration is given to financial need. **\$1000.**

5) Dr. Patricia Stephens Memorial Scholarship: Awarded to a graduate student for best essay in a non-designated study area. **\$450.**

6) Lloyd Dendinger Memorial Scholarship: Award for outstanding graduate student essay in American literature. **\$100.**

7) English Department Undergraduate Essay Contest: Award for best undergraduate student essay (from any English field: literature, rhet/comp, etc.) written during the 2008-09 academic year. **\$100.**

8) English Department Graduate Student Essay Contest: Award for best graduate student essay written during the 2008-09 academic year. **\$100.**

**Any student who has previously won a scholarship or award in one category is ineligible to reapply for the same category. However, previous winners may submit applications for any other category.*
