- 6 2. Explore and report on the problems faculty have with Groupwise (as opposed to Jaguar1). Why do we have two separate email systems? Do we need both?
- 6 3. Create and publish an inventory of software licenses available to faculty held by the University and by individual Colleges.
- 11 4. Explore and report on the possible development of wireless computing across campus—the teaching possibilities and technical issues surrounding it.
