The University of South Alabama Earth Sciences Department invites applications for a one-year (twelve-month) full-time, non-tenure track Geography Instructor position starting August 15, 2012. The candidate will teach a minimum of 12 credit hours per semester including the undergraduate courses: Introduction to Human Geography, World Regional Geography, and World Economic Geography. A Masters (or higher) degree in Geography is required. The candidate selected for this position must meet eligibility requirements to work legally in the United States for the duration of the term of employment. The candidate also must be able to communicate effectively in English.
