

Assignment 3: Geography classes

The Department of Earth Sciences offers 24 upper-division courses in Geography (some of which are cross-listed with Geology or Meteorology) (see attached). The 24 courses are divided between four divisions: human, physical, regional, and technical. For the next assignment, read the course descriptions of each of the courses, which are available in a course catalog.
