

HY102 - History of Western Civilization II

Attendance, participation and the following quizzes and exams will be used to evaluate student performance in this class. Quizzes and exams will be given as scheduled in the course outline and evaluated as indicated in the syllabus.

The non-essay questions on each quiz or exam may be any combination of true/false, fill-in-the-blank, multiple-choice, identify, or match type questions.

- Quiz 1 Questions drawn from chapters 13-15 of the text and lecture topics covered until the date of the quiz. All questions will be non-essay. Question values may vary. Total points will be 75.
- Midterm Part 1: Questions drawn from chapters 16-19 of the text and lecture topics covered since last quiz until the date of the exam. All questions will be non-essay. Question values may vary. Total points will be 75.
- Part 2: One essay question drawn from chapters 13-19 of the text and lecture topics covered since the beginning of class. Total points will be 25.
- Quiz 2 Questions drawn from chapters 20-22 of the text and lecture topics covered since midterm until the date of the quiz. All questions will be non-essay. Question values may vary. Total points will be 75.
- Final Part 1: Questions covering chapters 23-25 of the text and lecture topics covered since last quiz until the date of the exam. All questions will be non-essay. Question values may vary. Total points will be 75.
- Part 2: One essay question drawn from chapters 20-25 of the text and lecture topics covered since the Midterm. Total points will be 25.
- Part 3: One essay question drawn from chapters 13-25 of the text and lecture topics covered during the entire course. Points will be 50.

Attendance/Participation will be approximately 20% of the evaluation for the course.

Students will earn one or two points for each day they attend class. Only one point will be awarded if the student is either late or leaves early. With 44 days of class or review, 88 points can be earned through attendance. Up to 12 points may be awarded for participation in classroom discussion and overall contributions to the course giving the 100 expected points. In addition, up to 75 participation points can be earned for work outside of class as specified in the document on outside work. This gives the opportunity for a student to earn a total of 175 attendance and participation points.
