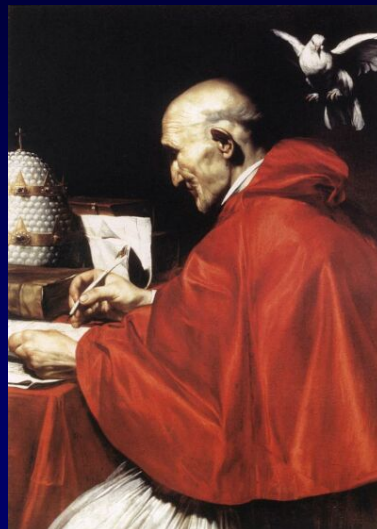

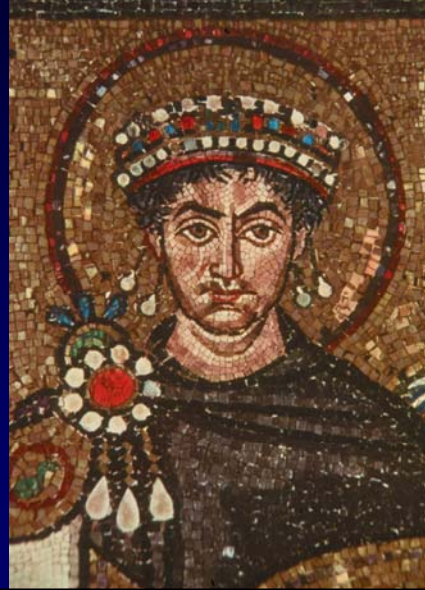

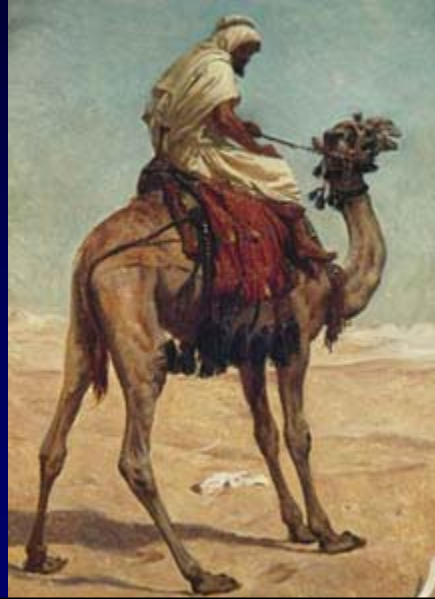
The Eastern Empire

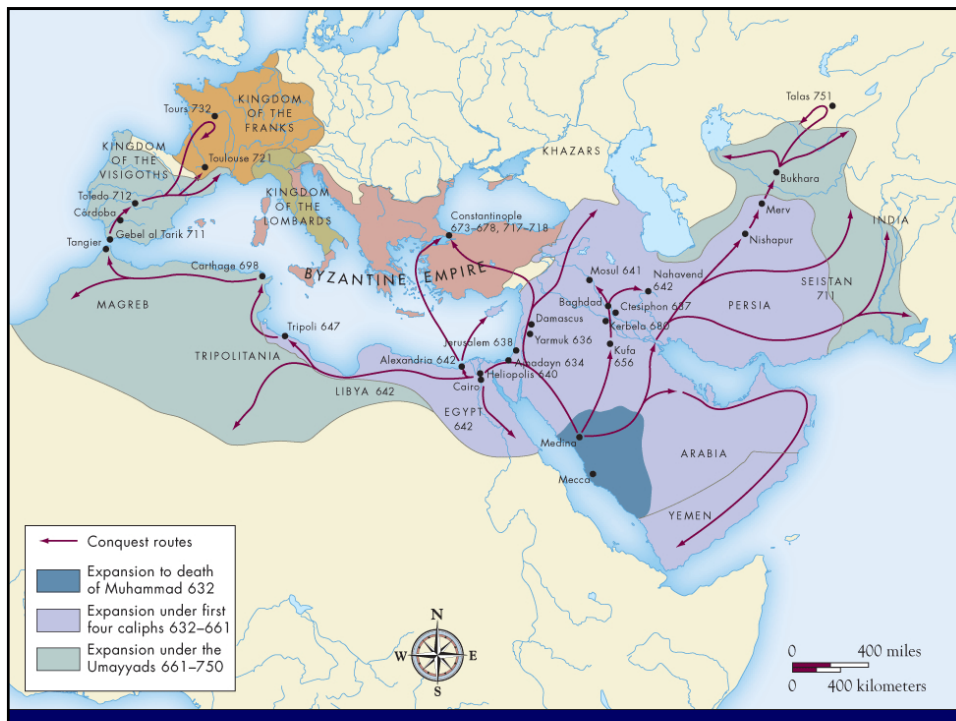
