

HY101-101 History of Western Civilization I

Attendance, participation and the following quizzes and exams will be used to evaluate student performance in this class. Quizzes and exams will be given as scheduled in the course outline and evaluated as indicated in the syllabus.

The non-essay questions on each quiz or exam may be any combination of true/false, fill-in-the-blank, multiple-choice, identify, or match type questions.

Attendance/Participation

Each student will start the course with 90 points in this category. Points will be added or subtracted as the semester progresses. Points may be subtracted for poor attendance, tardiness, or disruption of class. Points may be added for active participation in class and completion of extra work that shows intellectual progress and interest in the class. It is possible that the total points earned in this category could exceed the 100 points that will be graded.

Quiz 1 Questions drawn from chapters 1-3 of the text and lecture topic covered until the date of the quiz. All questions will be non-essay. Question values may vary. Total points will be 75.

Midterm Part 1: Questions drawn from chapters 4-6 of the text and lecture topics covered since last quiz until the date of the exam. All questions will be non-essay. Question values may vary. Total points will be 75.

Part 2: Multiple short essay questions drawn from chapters 1-6 of the text and lecture topics covered since last quiz until the date of the exam. Question values may vary. Total points will be 75.

Quiz 2 Questions drawn from chapters 7-9 of the text and lecture topics covered since midterm until the date of the quiz. All questions will be non-essay. Question values may vary. Total points will be 75.

Final Part 1: Questions covering chapters 10-12 of the text and lecture topics covered since last quiz until the date of the exam. All questions will be non-essay. Question values may vary. Total points will be 75.

Part 2: Multiple short essay questions drawn from chapters 7-12 of the text and lecture topics covered since last quiz until the date of the exam. Question values may vary. Total points will be 75.

Part 3: One essay question drawn from chapters 1-12 of the text and lecture topics covered during the entire course. Points will be 50.
