TITLE: Pharmacist

Shift: Rotating

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS: Graduation from a recognized school of Pharmacy as approved and accepted by the University of South Alabama. Licensed to practice pharmacy in the State of Alabama. Parenteral Certification, Controlled Substances certificate required.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS: : Provides family centered healthcare utilizing a holistic and interdisciplinary approach to deliver state of the art care to patients in accordance with the professional standards of pharmaceutical care. Abides by and enforces all compliance requirements and policies and adheres to hospital policies. Requires regular and prompt attendance and the ability to work the assigned schedule including overtime and call as required. Supervises, plans, and evaluates the care provided by other departmental employees or students as assigned. Requires minimal supervision to perform tasks. Performance of and supervision of pharmaceutical care activities and functions related to medication use and monitoring for all patient care areas. Safely performs clinical pharmaceutical care functions. Calculates doses correctly based upon weight, height and BSA. Reviews appropriateness of parenteral nutrition. Follows guidelines in chemotherapy and investigational drug preparation. States the purpose, rationale, precautions, and observations related to pharmacy functions. Maintains and operates equipment. Participates in studies, quality monitors, and drug evaluation. Performs patient care activities on the pharmacy computer system. Utilizes a PC or terminal to access the Hospital Information System or the Pharmacy Purchasing System. Performs general pharmacy duties such as filling/dispensing medications, preparing/dispensing IV solutions and compounding medications. Dispenses controlled substances as defined by the controlled substances permit. Confirms accuracy of work performed by pharmacy technicians, including unit dose carts. Reviews physician's orders for appropriate route, dose, scheduling, and potential drug interactions and consults as needed. Serves as a resource for medical and nursing staff. Provides information on medications for patients as needed. Communicates in person and via the telephone with patients, families, physicians and health care team and the ability to respond to overhead pages. Adheres to current Infection Control and Safety Standards. Demonstrates the ability to provide competent patient care to the following patient populations: neonate, pediatric, adolescent, adult, and geriatric. Other duties as assigned.
