**MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:** Graduation from a four year institution as approved and accepted by the University of South Alabama with major course work in Medical Technology. Registry eligible with the American Society of Clinical Pathologists or National Certification Agency as a Medical Technologist.

**ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:** After orientation and training, this employee demonstrates the ability to competently provide care to neonatal, infant, toddler, adolescent, adult and geriatric patient populations. Evaluates and solves problems related to collection and processing of biological specimens for analysis. Follows standard procedures to perform routine, timed and STAT laboratory test. Analyzes quality control data, makes judgements concerning the results. Abides by and enforces all hospital policies and procedures, including those pertaining to confidentiality. Documents results or actions in writing and by computer. Adheres to hospital policies and to current Infection Control and Safety Standards. Maintains instruments by performing maintenance procedures and calibration. Reports life threatening values. Operates and utilizes necessary programs on LIS, HIS, or PC. Effective verbal and written communications. Teaches instrument operation or procedures to medical technology students or new employees as assigned. Draws blood specimens from patients. Assumes responsibility for supervision of a section or shift on a temporary basis as delegated. Participates in continuing education activities. Utilizes proper body mechanics when moving, positioning, and transferring patients without assistance or with assistance when needed for patient safety and when moving equipment/supplies necessary to perform essential functions. Teaches instrument operation or procedures to Clinical Laboratory Science students or new employees as assigned. Uses standard precautions. Communicates and uses appropriate customer relations skills with physicians, patients, families, and healthcare team in person and via the telephone and the ability to respond to overhead pages. Regular and prompt attendance and the ability to work the assigned schedule including overtime. Other duties as assigned.
