TITLE: Registered Nurse I - Dialysis

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS: Graduation from an accredited school of nursing as approved and accepted by the University of South Alabama meeting the minimum standards set by the State of Alabama and one year dialysis experience. Licensed as a Registered Nurse in the State of Alabama.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS: Utilizes the nursing process to assess patients, plan individualized care, identify expected outcomes, and implement and evaluate nursing interventions for neonatal, pediatric, adolescent, adult, and geriatric patients. Performs therapeutic and/or diagnostic procedures as ordered. Administers medications including controlled substances by all routes. Starts IVs. Performs activities of daily living. Administers blood and blood products. Responds appropriately to emergency patient situations. Utilizes proper body mechanics when moving, positioning, and transferring patients and when moving equipment necessary to perform essential functions. Utilizes a PC or terminal to access the Hospital Information System. Demonstrates CPR according to American Heart Association standards. Performs Continuous Cycle Peritoneal Dialysis and Continuous Ambulatory Peritoneal Dialysis. Provides 24-hour coverage and consultation services for treatment of acute problems after normal operational hours. Assists in the modality choice of dialysis for the renal failure patient. Provides dialysis treatment at all USA facilities. Adheres to Hospital Policies and to current Infection Control and Safety standards. Communicates and uses appropriate customer relation skills with physicians, patients, families and health care team in person and via the telephone and the ability to respond to overhead pages. Maintains accurate and complete medical records. Serves as charge nurse when assigned. Regular and prompt attendance and the ability to work the assigned schedule including overtime and call if necessary. Other duties as assigned.
