MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS: Graduation from an accredited medical school, licensure with the state of Alabama as an MD, board certification eligible in primary care, family practice or internal medicine specialty. DEA registration, and eligible for USA Hospitals staff privileges.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS: Serves as medical director for the Student Health clinic and is responsible for the overall delivery of acute and chronic care to the students of the University of South Alabama; supervises clinical staff to include assigning duties, checking work, approving time off, signing timesheets and handling disciplinary issues; develops and recommends policy and procedure changes for the Student Health clinic; precepts medical students and residents rotating through the Student Health clinic; oversees the immunization compliance program; works closely with the Quality Improvement Coordinator and Practice Director to meet Accreditation Association for Ambulatory health Care (AAAHC) accreditation; performs duties and responsibilities of an internal medicine physician in a primary care practice to include examining, diagnosing, and treating a variety of diseases and injuries using applicable medical instruments and equipment; evaluates and counsels patients and obtains medical history; maintains medical records and codes records for billing purposes; administers or prescribes treatments, drugs, or injections; performs or orders tests and/or procedures to include gynecology exams; participates in the continuing Medical Education program; attends regular staff meetings; participates in the development and implementation of outcome oriented methods of quality assurance, goals, policies, procedures and programs and enhancement of funding for the student health center; abides by the medical staff by-laws, rules and regulations for the state, federal and USA hospitals and clinics; analyzes reports and findings of tests and examinations and diagnoses condition; refers to medical specialist for consultation as indicated; performs minor surgical procedures as required; dictates patient summary; regular and prompt attendance; ability to work schedule as defined and overtime as required.
