

LG 132 Fall 2010 Anda Oral Exam
General Information

Please be aware that the Oral Exam itself is located in the front of each custom edition of Anda.

Oral Exam Sign Up:

- Sign up on the LG 132 poster beginning Monday, November 15. (Poster will be located in the hallway just outside of the For. Lang. Dept. office, HUMB 322)
- Students will sign up individually for taking the Oral Exam.
- Students may NOT sign up other students.
- Students may NOT add sign up slots to the poster.
- Students may coordinate with another student so that s/he will be his/her partner. However knowing one's partner is NOT necessary.
- Be sure to remember the time you select to take your Oral Exam!

Additional comments about the Oral Exam:

- Show up to the Oral Exam at least 12 minutes before your scheduled exam time.
- Sit in the hallway until your name is called by an exam proctor (USA Spanish faculty.)
- Be prepared to tell your proctor when you have LG 132 (day/time) and your instructor's name.
- You may not have notes during the exam. The proctor will give you a clean copy of the Oral Exam (It will be exactly as it appears in the front of your custom edition of Anda.)
- The exam will last about 12 minutes---maximum.
- The proctor will just listen as you and your partner go over the Oral Exam. You will take turns calling out the items to each other. Your grade is an individual grade. Your partner's ability will NOT affect your grade whatsoever.
- The Oral Exam grade is 10% of your overall LG 132 grade.
- You will NOT receive your Oral Exam grade from the proctor. You will receive it at a later date from your own Spanish instructor.
- There are no make-ups for the Oral Exam . If you fail to appear for your Oral Exam, you will automatically receive a "0." If you fail to sign up to take the Oral Exam, you will automatically receive a "0."
