Textbook: The textbook for this course is *Calculus (5th edition)* by Stewart (Thompson, Brooks/Cole 2003). We will cover much of the first four chapters of the book.

Grading: Grades will be determined according to the following:

Homework/Quizzes — 20%
Three Midterms — 55%
Final Exam — 25%

Exams: There will be three midterm tests and a final exam. Tentative dates for the midterms are **Friday, September 24; Monday, October 25; and Friday, December 3**. The final exam is scheduled for 8:00am-10:00am, **Monday, December 13**.
