Note: NU 518 Advanced Nursing Assessment is required if you've never had a Graduate level Across the Lifespan Physical Assessment course. This course must be completed in the Summer Semester, before clinicals begin Fall Semester 1st year. To register for this class, contact the Office of Admissions (251-460-6141) and ask that your admission semester be changed from fall to summer semester. If you were admitted spring semester, there is no need to contact Admissions.

Note: NU 545 Physiological Basis of Advanced Nursing Practice is required if you've never had a Graduate level Physiology or Pathophysiology course, NU 578 Pharmacology for Advanced Practice Nurses is required if you've never had a Graduate level Pharmacology. These courses must be completed before Summer Semester 1st year.

Note: Your ability to progress in the curriculum is dependent upon your following this schedule. For example, some courses are only taught once each year and many have pre-requisites. If you are unable to enroll as projected, contact the graduate office for a revised schedule.
