**Note:** NU 518 Advanced Nursing Assessment is required if you've never had a Graduate level Across the Lifespan Physical Assessment course. This course must be completed in the Summer Semester, before clinicals begin Fall Semester 1<sup>st</sup> year. To register for this class, contact the Office of Admissions (251-460-6141) and ask that your admission semester be changed from fall to summer semester. If you were admitted spring semester, there is no need to contact Admissions.

**Note:** NU 545 Physiological Basis of Advanced Nursing Practice is required if you've never had a Graduate level Physiology or Pathophysiology course, NU 578 Pharmacology for Advanced Practice Nurses is required if you've never had a Graduate level Pharmacology. These courses must be completed before Summer Semester 1st year, as shown above.

**Note:** Your ability to progress in the curriculum is dependent upon your following this schedule. For example, some courses are only taught once each year and many have pre-requisites. If you are unable to enroll as projected, contact the graduate office for a revised schedule.
